Ten Critical Areas of Operation

Critical Area #1: General Health and Safety Guidelines;

General Health and Safety Guidelines will be followed as directed by the CDC/NJDOE and MCVSD

Critical Area #2: Classrooms, Testing, and Therapy Rooms;

- Maintenance will address any necessary added ventilation, and air filters will be replaced monthly.
- We are anticipating hand sanitizer stations to be installed throughout the building and at entrance and exits.
- Signage throughout the building will remind the students and staff to wash their hands, cover their mouths, wear masks at all times, maintain social distancing.

Critical Area #3: Transportation

Students will be managed by the resident school district for appropriate guidelines

Critical Area #4: Common Areas, Student Flow

- Students will enter in a single file, while maintaining socially distanced spacing, through the Nurse's entrance door.
- Students will be in the cafeteria holding area until released to their homeroom.
- There will be no use of lockers.
- CLASS Academy and Shared Time students will dismiss at different times to stagger and maintain social distancing guidelines.
- Students will follow the bell schedule as per their assigned schedule.

Critical Area #5: Screening, PPE, and Response to Students and Staff Presenting Symptoms;

- CLASS Anticipates the school nurse will complete the morning screenings for all staff and students.
- Students who are suspected of COVID-19 symptoms will be isolated in the nurse's office.

Critical Area #6: Contact Tracing;

- The school nurse is the delegate to communicate with the local health department.

Critical Area #7: Facilities Cleaning Practices;

- How do you anticipate cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces and objects during the day?
 - *The Day custodian will clean hallways and touch points, between periods. Students and teachers will clean inside classrooms and work stations.*
- How do you anticipate cleaning and disinfecting student and staff restrooms?
 - *Bathroom touch points such as fixture handles, door latches, flush valves, sinks, and mirrors will be sanitized throughout the day. The bathrooms will be closed for full disinfection once during the day custodians' 8-hour shift. It is preferable that this occurs near or at mid-day. All bathrooms will be disinfected again each evening.*

Critical Area #8: Meals;

- Students will eat in the cafeteria and practice social distancing guidelines. Lunch orders will be taken in advance to avoid a lunch line.
- Staff will use the faculty room and conference room for their lunch period.
- Custodian will clean the cafeteria after usage of the CLASS Academy lunch.
- Free/Reduced lunch students will give the secretary their lunch order in the morning.

Critical Area #9: Recess/Physical Education;

- CLASS Academy students will be using Google Classroom for virtual gym coordinated between Dr. Christopher and Joe Diver Principal (ALPS) and the ALPS PE instructor.

Critical Area #10: Field Trips, Extra-Curricular Activities, and Use of Facilities Outside School Hours;

- There will be NO field trips, in-person extracurricular activities, or outside use of the facilities
